

## 2016-17 Elementary Gifted Services Timeline

### Grades 2 - 5

<b>Grades 2 and 4</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Families of <b>new-to-district</b> second and fourth graders should contact their gifted specialist if they wish to have their child assessed for gifted services.</li><li>• September 29: Elementary Parent Informational Meeting 6:30 – 8:30 PM at Edison Board Room.</li><li>• January 30 – March 3, 2017: CogAT administered to all grade 2 and 4 students.</li><li>• Week of March 27, 2017: Students notified of qualification for gifted services for following year. Students who qualify for gifted services will begin classes in Fall 2017.</li><li>• April 19, 2017: Last day for Grade 2 and 4 students who did not qualify on the CogAT to request portfolio to qualify for gifted services for the 2017-18 academic year</li><li>• April 20 – May 10, 2017: Portfolios completed at school under supervision of gifted specialists</li><li>• Week of May 15, 2017: Portfolios evaluated by a panel of gifted specialists</li><li>• Week of May 22, 2017: Portfolio qualification/non-qualification results communicated to families.</li></ul>
<b>Grade 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Families of <b>new-to-district</b> third graders should contact their gifted specialist if they wish to have their child assessed for gifted services.</li><li>• September 29: Elementary Parent Informational Meeting 6:30 – 8:30 PM at Edison Board Room.</li><li>• April 19, 2017: Last day for Grade 3 students to request portfolio to qualify for gifted services for the 2017-18 academic year</li><li>• April 20 – May 10, 2017: Portfolios completed at school under supervision of gifted specialists</li><li>• Week of May 15, 2017: Portfolios evaluated by a panel of gifted specialists</li><li>• Week of May 22, 2017: Portfolio qualification/non-qualification results communicated to families.</li></ul>
<b>Grade 5</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Families of <b>new-to-district</b> fifth graders should contact their gifted specialist if they wish to have their child assessed for gifted services.</li><li>• September 29: Elementary Parent Informational Meeting 6:30 – 8:30 PM at Edison Board Room.</li><li>• October 28: Friedell Highly Gifted Program portfolio requests due</li><li>• November 1–30, 2016 Portfolios completed at school under supervision of a gifted specialist</li><li>• Nov. 17: Fifth Grade Open House at Friedell Middle School</li><li>• Week of December 5, 2016: Highly Gifted portfolios evaluated by a panel of gifted specialists</li><li>• Week of December 12, 2016: All portfolio qualification/non-qualification results communicated to families. Students who qualify for Highly Gifted program at Friedell will be mailed a paper application.</li><li>• January 17, 2017: Applications for Highly Gifted Middle School Program at Friedell are due</li><li>• Week of January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017: Families notified of status for Highly Gifted program at Friedell</li><li>• Week of May 22, 2017: Families are notified of middle school math placement by mail</li></ul>
