- Week of March 27, 2017: Students notified of qualification for gifted services for following year. Students who qualify for gifted services will begin classes in Fall 2017.
- April 19, 2017: Last day for Grade 2 and 4 students who did not qualify on the CogAT to request portfolio to qualify for gifted services for the 2017-18 academic year
- April 20 May 10, 2017: Portfolios completed at school under supervision of gifted specialists
- Week of May 15, 2017: Portfolios evaluated by a panel of gifted specialists
- Week of May 22, 2017: Portfolio qualification/non-qualification results communicated to families.

Grade 3

- April 19, 2017: Last day for Grade 3 students to request portfolio to qualify for gifted services for the 2017-18 academic year
- April 20 May 10, 2017: Portfolios completed at school under supervision of gifted specialists
- Week of May 15, 2017: Portfolios evaluated by a panel of gifted specialists
- Week of May 22, 2017: Portfolio qualification/non-qualification results communicated to families.

Grade 5

- Families of **new-to-district** fifth graders should contact their gifted specialist if they wish to have their child assessed for gifted services.
- September 29: Elementary Parent Informational Meeting 6:30 8:30 PM at Edison Board Room.
- October 28: Friedell Highly Gifted Program portfolio requests due
- November 1–30, 2016 Portfolios completed at school under supervision of a gifted specialist
- Nov. 17: Fifth Grade Open House at Friedell Middle School
- Week of December 5, 2016: Highly Gifted portfolios evaluated by a panel of gifted specialists
- Week of December 12, 2016: All portfolio qualification/non-qualification results communicated to families. Students who qualify for Highly Gifted program at Friedell will be mailed a paper application.
- January 17, 2017: Applications for Highly Gifted Middle School Program at Friedell are due
- Week of January 30th, 2017: Families notified of status for Highly Gifted program at Friedell
- Week of May 22, 2017: Families are notified of middle school math placement by mail
